Iam startled by my everyday experiences and am constantly trying to paint them. Certainthings I see connect to something I can't quite get a handle on withoutpainting them. There is also the problemof how to put the painting together as a material thing and in abstract terms:structure, color, mark-making, laying on the paint, drawing with the paint, thick, thin, smooth, rough.

Thesephysical things keep evolving. They double back on themselves and reappear inaltered ways. I want to get below the surface of the material when I paint to somethingessential about my experience of looking and seeing -- something that moves meor I find intriguing or funny. The ability to paint what I see requires constantinvestigation, trial and error, and practice; it is a skill that comes from looking.

Mypaintings are a result of that search.
